American Jazz Group To Perform in Paris

PARIS, Oct. 24.—A new Amer-
ican jazz quartet, the
"Creative Construction Com-
pany of Chicago," will give a
concert of their own composi-
tions at the Paris Museum of
Modern Art (Metro Iena3 at
6.15 a.m. tomorrow as part of
the Paris Biennial.

Sunday, they go to Tournai, Bel-
gium, to play in a "giant" hippy
concert. And then on Monday,
the quartet will give a concert
at the American Cultural Cen-
ter, 3 Rue du Dragon, at 8.30 p.m.
