## INTERNATIONAL EXHIBITION DIARY

## PARIS BIENNALE

The 12th Paris Biennale, representing 45 countries, covers five venues. At the Grand Palais, Ave Winston-Churchill, are over 100 international painters and sculptors. America's representatives have been felled by Reagan's cuts, so are being transmitted, instead, by SLOWSCAN, at Le Musee d'Art Moderne, 11 Ave du President Wilson, together with displays of sound and voice (including 'le musique punk'), innovative French photography, international experimental cinema and video-art. 30 architect-partnerships exhibit schemes on the theme of 'modernity or the spirit of the times' at L'Ecole des Beaux-Arts, 14 rue Bonaparte. More than 400 books, produced entirely by artists, are on show at L'Ambassade d'Australie, 66 Ave d'Iena, and 29 French artists' studios will be recreated at the Centre Georges Pompidou, Place Beaubourg/Rue St-Merri (until Nov 1 only). The Biennale lasts from Oct 2-Nov 14.
